

Why RE2008 in Korea?

Korea is one of the fast growing markets for renewable energy technology as shown in the graph below. It is estimated that the photovoltaic market size, for example, reached about 50 MW in 2007. The Korean market is expected to grow even faster in 2008 with the high feed-in tariff rates as given in the table below. The renewable energy industry is booming as a result of the support from the Government. Korea has an aggressive target to increase the renewable energy contribution in the total energy consumption up to 5% by 2011 and to 9% by 2030.

The Korean market and R&D effort will be magnified when the draft for the 3rd New and Renewable Energy Basic Plan is finalized in 2008. The Plan contains R&D and deployment plans toward 2018. Ultimately Korea has a vision of achieving the 'Energy Independence' through the renewable energy in a foreseeable future.

The Korean government understands the significance of the R&D effort to make the renewable energy technology cost-competitive against the conventional energy sources and to sustain the market for the healthy and growing industry. The Korean government has increased the renewable energy budget by more than 20% on the average over the last five years to about \$550 million in 2008.





We ask the authors to submit abstracts according to the following guidelines. Papers will be presented in one of two types: 1) oral presentation, or 2) poster presentation. Authors are asked to mark their preference for presentation type. However, the Program Committee may recommend the oral presentation type for a limited number of abstracts. Please read the instructions below carefully before submission. If further information is required, please feel free to contact RE2008 Secretariat at secretariat@re2008.org.

General Instructions

- All abstracts should be written in English up to 400 words (size A4) with MS-Word
 format which provide a concise statement of objectives and a summary of important
 results without using any special characters, tables or figures. Any published articles or
 abstracts with pending results will not be accepted.
- They should be submitted electronically through our website (www.re2008.org).
- 3. The accepted abstract will be published in the Abstract Book for distribution at the conference.
- 4. Abstracts must conform to the following outline:
 - A. Conference topics and corresponding key words
 - B. Preferred type of presentation (Oral & Poster)
 - C. Full title (15 point with bold and in capital)
 - D. Information of authors including full name, affiliation, phone/fax/e-mail and complete mailing address of the corresponding author
 - E. Full name and affiliation of co-authors
- Preferred font is Times New Roman of 9 point and bold should be used for title including major headings.
- It is sole responsibility of the presenting authors to ensure accuracy of contents, spellings and presentations, as their abstracts will be published exactly as submitted.

Submission & Process

- Submission Deadline: March 31, 2008
- Abstracts submitted by mail or fax will not be considered for reviewing by the Program Committee.
- Presenting and corresponding authors will receive confirmation by e-mail
 automatically after the abstracts are submitted. If you do not receive any confirmation

- The notification for the acceptance or rejection will be completed by April 30, 2008.





Visas

Any foreign visitors wishing to enter Korea must have a valid passport and obtain a Korean visa. Please contact Embassy of the Republic of Korea in your country to receive further information on visa regulations and refer to the website (http://www.gf4.go.kr).

Weather

Korea lies in the temperate zone and has four distinct seasons; spring, summer, fall, and winter. Busan in October is in the middle of fall. Please visit to the Korean Metrological Administration for the current weather (http://www.kma.go.kr).

Currency & Banking

Korean unit of currency is the Won (Indicated as \mathbb{W}). Coin denominations are $\mathbb{W}10,\mathbb{W}50,\mathbb{W}100$ and $\mathbb{W}500$. Bank notes are $\mathbb{W}1,000,\mathbb{W}5,000$ and $\mathbb{W}10,000$. Foreign bank notes and traveler's checks can be exchanged into Korean won at foreign exchange banks and other authorized money changers. US \$1 is equivalent to approximately $\mathbb{W}945$ as of January 2008. Credit cards, including VISA, American Express, Diner's Club, Master Card and JCB, are accepted at hotels, department stores, and restaurants.

Electricity

Outlets for 220 volts / 60 cycles are used.

Time Difference

Korean time is 9 hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+9).
